**The New Testament Lesson:** Romans 6:1-4

**Confession of Faith:** *The Canons of Dort (1618-1619), 2.1-2.2*

Pastor: God is not only supremely merciful, but also supremely just. And His justice requires (as He has revealed Himself in His Word), that our sins committed against His infinite majesty should be punished, not only with temporal, but with eternal punishment, both in body and soul; which we cannot escape unless satisfaction be made to the justice of God.
